What is CEHR? Community Electronic Health Record or CEHR is a quick and convenient way to view your current Montcalm Care Network records such as current medication list, contact information and history of services. It allows the opportunity to send and receive non-emergency messages to your primary clinician and request records to be sent electronically.

Accessing your Electronic Health Record:

New Users: Create an account:

- MCN will give you a Case Number and Personal ID Number (PIN)
- Click "Get Started"
- Fill out each section and click "Create Account"

Returning Users:

- Click "Log In"
- Enter User Name and Password

Click to end your session. Always logout after each session.



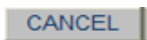
Click to go back one screen.



Click calendar to find a date quickly.




My Home	The starting spot and holds your health record information.
My Personal Information	Contact information and emergency contacts-People you stated should be contacted when needed. My Messages gives you a way to send/receive a non-emergency electronic message to/from your case worker.
My Health Record	This section has five areas to learn about your health; allergies listed, diagnosis, medications you are taking, your blood pressure, weight and other vitals. Test results are also listed.
My Appointments	Upcoming appointments will be listed. Call 989-831-7520 to cancel or reschedule your appointment if needed.
My Documents	Health information when you have asked for or the agency has sent you.
Continuity of Care	All your Health Record information. You can send it privately and safely to your providers.
Assistance Programs	Information on state, federal or other programs which might help you.
My Account	This section allows you to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Update your log in information • Change your password • Add another agency so you can see your health record with them. • View who has seen your health record, when and what was viewed.
